#### 22.42 Declarations of Interest

22.42.1 There were no declarations of interest.

#### 22.43 Minutes of Previous Meeting

22.43.1 The minutes of the meeting of 11 July 2022 were approved and signed as correct.

#### 22.44 Matters Arising

22.44.1 Increased insurance cover has been taken at an additional cost of £75 for the year.

The speed sign was moved following the previous meeting.

#### 22.45 Finance

22.45.1 Receipts & Expenditure

A brief summary of the financial situation was given. £3660.04 closing balance of which £1008.71 is CIL funds.

22.45.2 Barclays Savings Account

Total stands at £746.82.

#### 22.46 Planning

22.46.1 22/01895/FUL Internal alterations & extension – Mr & Mrs R Callard-Scoble -no issues.

#### 22.47 Councillor Report

22.47.1 *HDC/NYCC – DW* reported that the HDC & NYCC local government reorganisation discussions were ongoing. It is proposed that six planning areas/committees be formed, relating to the six proposed Parliamentary divisions but due to a host of factors, the matter is far from clear cut.

#### 22.48 Review of Correspondence Received

- 22.48.1 PLANNED ROAD CLOSURE NOTIFICATION SW-35315 Road from Salmon Lane to West Lodge Track. The closure will be in place for a period of 12 days between 12 to 23 September 2022 to allow for overhead pole replacement works on behalf of Northern Power Grid.
- 22.48.2 The following notices had all been circulated to councillors:
  - YLCA meeting 2 November 2022 with NY Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner
  - HDC Consultation Domestic Extensions
  - HDC Consultation Council Tax Reduction

22.48.3 An email received from resident Mr David Powell posed questions and instigated a discussion around identifying and assisting Carthorpe residents who may be struggling with rising fuel bills and the cost of living. DW reported on 'Well Oiled', the oil buying group in his village. It was suggested that perhaps a similar model could be adopted to benefit Carthorpe residents. Further investigations to be undertaken. It was agreed that £100 should be donated to Citizens Advice to assist them in their face-to-face work and an approach made to investigate closer

cooperation. Posters to be requested.

It was suggested that another potential route to reaching out to residents in need was via the Coffee Mornings which are held weekly in the Community Hall. Mrs M Hudson-Jaques to be approached.

A page advert in Village Life was also suggested as a means of reaching out.

#### 22.49 **Matters for Discussion**

22.49.1 CIL Project Update

> £1008.71 left in the CIL Fund and a further £1819.13 due to be received in October. Agreed that planning for potential future projects should be put on hold until later in the year.

22.49.2 Permissive Path/Footpath report

> JJ reported that the bridge for the footpath had been delivered and that some work towards stripping the paint had been undertaken. Further restoration is required before installation by YSB.

> CC asked for clarity on who is to be responsible for the bridge and it's ongoing

A request to be made for exact location of the bridge - to be pegged by NY Footpaths team.

22.49.3 Youth Club Revival

> JJ reported that parents were interested in a revival of the Youth Club. Mrs M Hudson-Jaques and Mr A Ashford to be approached.

22.49.4 **Unification Readiness** 

NY Devolution Deal Consultation paper had been circulated.

22.49.5 Website

> A new Carthorpe PC website has been kindly set up by Mr S Carter, saving the PC approximately £250/annum. Thanks were expressed. Tutorials and final tweaks to be made before going live on 1 September 2022.
